## (U) Did you know?

(U//FOUO) According to the U.S. Geological Survey, there is the possibility that flood water sensors could be mistaken for IEDs. These sensors have been placed to track flood waters from storms and may be attached to trees, bridge supports, telephone poles, and piers readily identified as infrastructure.
