HMRT Minimum Personal Equipment Requirements

Member Department's Responsibility:

1. Department duty uniform
2. Duty boot (Department issued or approved)
3. Cold weather thermal wear, including gloves

WW HMRT's Responsibility (based on team needs):

1. HMRT logo t-shirts (1 long sleeve and 1 short sleeve)
2. HMRT logo ball cap
3. HMRT logo winter hat
4. HMRT log hi-vis jacket (cold & inclement weather)

USAR Minimum Equipment Requirements

Member Department's Responsibility:

1. 511 Tactical TDU pant & shirt (Navy Blue)
 - a. WW USAR is responsible for name tape and patches
2. Uniform rappel belt – CMC Type I Uniform Rappel Egress Belt
3. Carhart Cold Weather Gear - Jacket & Bib overalls (black)
4. Globe Technical Rescue 10" Boot (NFPA compliant)
5. Rescue glove (Shelby, Ringers, or similar style)
6. Thermal underwear
7. Goggles – helmet style
8. Knee Pads – Technical Rescue type
9. Eye protection – ANSI approved
10. Tape measure – 25 ft

- 2. USAR Deployment Backpack – LA Rescue 72 hour USAR Deployment Pack**
- 3. USAR gear bag – LA Rescue Long Crew Bag**
- 4. USAR fanny pack – LA Rescue Fanny Pack**
- 5. USAR logo hi-vis jacket (cold & inclement weather)**
- 6. USAR logo black hooded rain jacket**
- 7. Rain pant – Carhart, black**
- 8. Rescue Gloves**
- 9. USAR logo ball cap**
- 10. USAR logo winter cap**
- 11. Rescue Whistle**
